## FROM OUR President & CEO

Every year is full of moments that define it and when we look back, the year often carries a theme. This year, there's no hesitation in aligning with a few: resilience, hope and love.

This past year has tested us as an organization, as a community, and as individuals. The atrocities of October 7, 2023 and every day since then have presented new challenges, fears and opportunities.

Together, our community raised over \$2.4MM for the Jewish Federation of North America's Israel Emergency Campaign, over \$80,000 of which went directly to support the families of Kibbutz Be'eri who lost more than we can ever imagine. These funds raised are an incredible milestone achievement of the past year, only made more impressive by also raising \$2.5MM for our JFund Annual Campaign. The generosity of our community continues to amaze us, and knows no limits. We've been able to fund truly unique programs and projects that reach our brothers and sisters in Israel and have made meaningful contributions to their lives.

In Jewish South Jersey, we see a future that is full of hope and prosperity. We're thrilled to welcome Kellman Brown Academy as an agency of the Federation, and we're excited to work more closely with Jewish Senior Housing and Healthcare Service and support them with development and marketing priorities. We've also entered into a strategic alliance with the Jewish Federation of Princeton Mercer Bucks, which will create a stronger Jewish connection for over 65,000 individuals in five counties through programs, services, and special events.

This past year, we've seen rising rates of antisemitism, particularly on our college campuses. These are challenging and concerning times, but thanks to the steadfast work of the Jewish Community Relations Council, our commitment to education and advocacy against antisemitism and all forms of hate are paramount. Coupled with the intricate and exceptional work of our community security model, JFed Security, we are making Jewish South Jersey a better, safer place to live. There's no place as special as South Jersey.

Throughout this report, you'll see how the work we're committed to doing in our community is grounded in Jewish values. Jewish values are identified with Hebrew words, such as **Tikkun Olam** and **Chesed** but their meaning transcends those in the Jewish community, which is special and something not to be taken for granted. You'll also notice QR codes interspersed with what you'll read, which will take you on a journey through the year in a new way that we know will leave you inspired.

# TIKKUN OLAM

## Repairing the World

**Tikkun Olam** is at the heart of the Jewish Federation. It's the driving force behind every program, service, and financial assistance package we provide to individuals of all ages who are in need.

After the October 7th attack on Israel carried out by the terrorist organization Hamas, we saw a local, national, and global community that was hurting, in despair, and in serious need of repair and support. Together, as a community, we turned our devastation into action.

We immediately mobilized to fundraise for Jewish Federations of North America (JFNA)'s Israel Emergency Campaign (IEC) to give aid to victims of the terror attack and to support Israel. Thanks to our dedicated partners, we organized a variety of events bringing the South Jersey community together to grieve with each other, console one another, and fundraise for victims of terror and antisemitism. These events included a solidarity gathering; an empty Shabbat table; a solidarity concert featuring Neshama Carlebach; a comedy show with Joe Matarese; Faces of October Seventh - an October 7th survivor testimonial; an Evening with Noa Tishby, Israel's former Special Envoy for combating antisemitism and delegitimization;

a conversation about antisemitism with comedian and actor Michael Rapaport and Real Housewife of New Jersey Jenn Fessler; and so much more.

Beyond these events, we partnered with Cooper University Health Care to send trauma surgeons to Israel, providing the Advanced Surgical Skills for Exposure in Trauma (ASSET) course to Israel's surgeons in need of extra trauma training. We teamed up with the Israel grassroots organization P24 to bring displaced families from Israel to South Jersey so ten children could experience the magic of JCC Camps at Medford for two weeks. Our Director of Special Needs, Adam Roth, worked closely with a family in South Jersey, while he was in Israel, to find and return their dog Jinx, who had been left behind in Israel.

We touched countless lives around the world and shed many tears. Through all of our acts to repair the world, and through the overwhelmingly generous **tzedakah** from our community, we found catharsis, and we healed a little bit together.

## GEMILUT CHASADIM & HACHALA Acts of Loving Kindness & Inclusiveness

Our older adults and special needs communities are near and dear to the Jewish Federation. The individuals in these populations should have the opportunity to achieve their highest potential and lead independent and fulfilled lives.

Loving kindness and inclusiveness are the foundation of our programs and services that support older adults and individuals with disabilities, as well as their family members, to provide them with their best quality of life.

Daily programs and services include offerings like Aleph Home Care and its Adult Day Center program, which provide care and socialization for older adults respectively, as well as Weinberg Commons, our award-winning

affordable housing community for older adults (55+) and adults with special needs in Cherry Hill, NJ. It's at the Weinberg Commons complex where many beautifully inclusive activities take place for all to enjoy, such as our Shavuot Block Party.

Our various agencies provide countless social and recreational activities as well as support to both older adults and individuals with disabilities.

The Jewish Federation, the Katz JCC (JCC), and Jewish Family and Children's Service of Southern New Jersey (JFCS) collaborated to host a Disability Inclusion Resource Fair. The event served as a vibrant hub where individuals and families came together, connected, and explored the wide range of resources available to support them and foster an inclusive community in South Jersey.

We also partnered with the JCC and JFCS to host a private screening of "Thirteen," which was directed by South Jersey native Allison Norlian, a three-time Emmy-nominated journalist, writer, and co-founder of BirdMine, a production company focused on amplifying the voices and stories of people with disabilities and other groups underrepresented within society. Dedicated to Norlian's mom and sister and inspired by real life, the film tells the story of a mother fighting to have a bat mitzvah for her non-speaking,

provided in critical support from JFCS to Holocaust Survivors, offering solutions for their daily needs while fostering individual well-being and social connection

developmentally disabled, and terminally ill daughter. Norlian's sister Becky was the first non-speaking, developmentally disabled person to have a bat mitzvah at her synagogue decades ago. The Jewish Federation's donation to the film greenlit the project and made us one of the movie's producers.

Jewish Senior Housing and Healthcare Service (JSHHS) launched their Lions Gate Meet our Match Campaign, which - thanks to a matching grant from the Raymond & Gertrude R. Saltzman Foundation - is raising funds for assisted living and skilled nursing residents who are living beyond what their financial planning entailed so that they can continue to live with grace and dignity.

Additionally, we are proud to have completely renovated the Jonathan Sinay Building, which will open its doors this fall. Located at 1721 Springdale Road in Cherry Hill, the building, which has been owned and operated by JFSNJ since 2014, has been completely renovated and will serve as the new home to the Aleph Adult Day Center and JFCS' To Our Positive Success (TOPS) Day Habilitation Program. There, older adults can engage in socialization with safe oversight, while individuals with special needs learn vocational and life skills and build a bright social life.

With loving kindness and inclusiveness at the forefront of our projects, we will continue to create opportunities for older adults and individuals with special needs to thrive.

# CHINUCH Education

**Chinuch** - education - is essential to achieving part of our mission: to ensure the continuity of a vibrant Jewish community locally, in Israel and around the world.

This year was a meaningful year for us in the education space. Kellman Brown Academy (KBA), a Jewish Day School in Voorhees, NJ, became a formal agency of the Jewish Federation.

We hosted our first Jewish Educator Professional Development Program thanks to funding from Jewish Community Foundation, Inc. of Southern New Jersey. Presenters facilitated breakout sessions supporting teachers in their commitment to providing quality Jewish education to our community at every age level.

The Jewish Community Relations Council (JCRC) of Southern New Jersey, a Jewish Federation agency, met with local school

administrators to address antisemitism and continues to provide Holocaust education through the Esther Raab Holocaust Museum & Goodwin Education Center.

The JCRC also spreads education about Jewish culture and Israel through its ShinShinim program. The ShinShinim are high school graduates who defer their Israel Defense Forces service for a year abroad sharing their love and knowledge of Israel. The ShinShinim and JCC Camps at Medford community are equally fortunate that the Shinshinim spend their summer at camp. This year's camp curriculum theme was "Jewish Journey Throughout History," an educational experience highlighting Jewish moments like the Jewish people's immigration to America in the early 1900s and the creation of the State of Israel.

During the school year, we brought Jewish youth together to learn through our Teen Speaker Series. We continue to facilitate PJ Library, a program that sends Jewish children's books to families in Burlington, Gloucester, and Camden counties each month. PJ Library is free to these families with thanks to the Harold Grinspoon Foundation, partnerships with local philanthropists, individuals' donations and the Jewish Federation of Southern New Jersey.

We are confident that our community will continue to grow stronger together through meaningful education no matter your age and stage of life.

# RUACH

## The Spirit & Power of Community

The Hebrew word **ruach**, which translates to “spirit,” is a Jewish value that truly embodies the community - we see it taking place daily and in many forms. We might think about it most often as it relates to summer day camps and the joy that exists every day in the liveliness of children, but here in Jewish South Jersey, it carries many more levels of significance.

Using a public voice is one of the most powerful ways to demonstrate this, and in the days and weeks after October 7, 2023, our community showed up. SJ residents crossed the bridge to participate in the Philadelphia March for Israel on October 17th, where they joined thousands who gathered to show unwavering support for Israel, praying for those who were (and still are, at time of printing) held in captivity in Gaza.

Similarly, over 14 buses traveled with the Jewish Federation of Southern New Jersey (JFSNJ) to the March for Israel in Washington, D.C. on November 14. Amongst the vast 290,000 people in attendance, Jewish South Jersey showed their **ruach** for this monumental moment of Jewish history.

The Jewish Federation's commitment to fighting antisemitism, particularly in the wake of October 7th, and the climbing rates of antisemitic incidents across the country, has been steadfast. Together with

our Jewish Community Relations Council (JCRC), there has been lots of meaningful work and **ruach** happening in this priority area. JCRC has been a relentless advocate in the community for the importance of government throughout New Jersey to adapt the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) definition for antisemitism locally, statewide, and nationally.

Over the summer, JFSNJ displayed a powerful message on a billboard at the high-traffic intersection of Route 70 and Route 38. The message (as seen in photo above) displayed how JFSNJ strives in every moment to spread love and gratitude.

Our world is an overwhelming, complicated place that will always present challenges we must face.

# BITACHON & AVTACHA Protection & Security

As the Jewish community's central hub for connection in South Jersey, and with the global rise in antisemitism, the Jewish Federation of Southern New Jersey (JFSNJ) has a responsibility to provide our people with **bitachon** and **avtacha** - protection and security.

Our JFed Security agency, which serves six of the nine Jewish Federations in New Jersey and the Jewish Federation that encompasses the entire state of Delaware, continues to grow and make critical investments to protect the community.

This past year, JFed Security purchased portable weapon detection systems to be deployed at events to further secure our properties. It invested in vehicles, which are deployed as an added layer of security. Branded with JFed Security logos and colors, these vehicles are used to transport equipment and guards, while also serving as

an outward-facing deterrent as it messages JFed Security is on-site and protecting the location.

JFed Security's highly trained full-time professional team is supported by over 50 part-time armed security guards, all retired municipal, county, state and federal law enforcement. The team monitors open-source information to track extremist rhetoric and activity. The team also includes three CPR/AED

instructors, an emergency operations plan writer, and an EMT.

JFed Security offers Situational Awareness Training, Active Threat Training, Stop the Bleed Training, and Scenario Training. It also offers threat and vulnerability risk assessments and access to intelligence briefs.

Thanks to JFed Security's hard work and generous individual donors, LiveSecure funding through Jewish Federations of North America, and State and Federal grants, our community continues to practice and celebrate our Judaism safely.

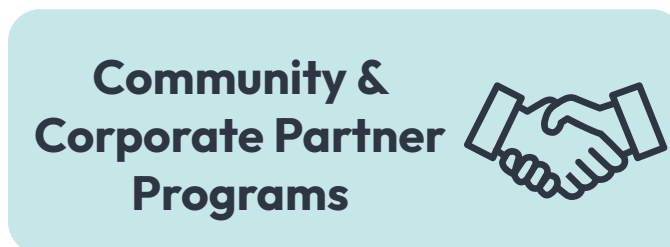

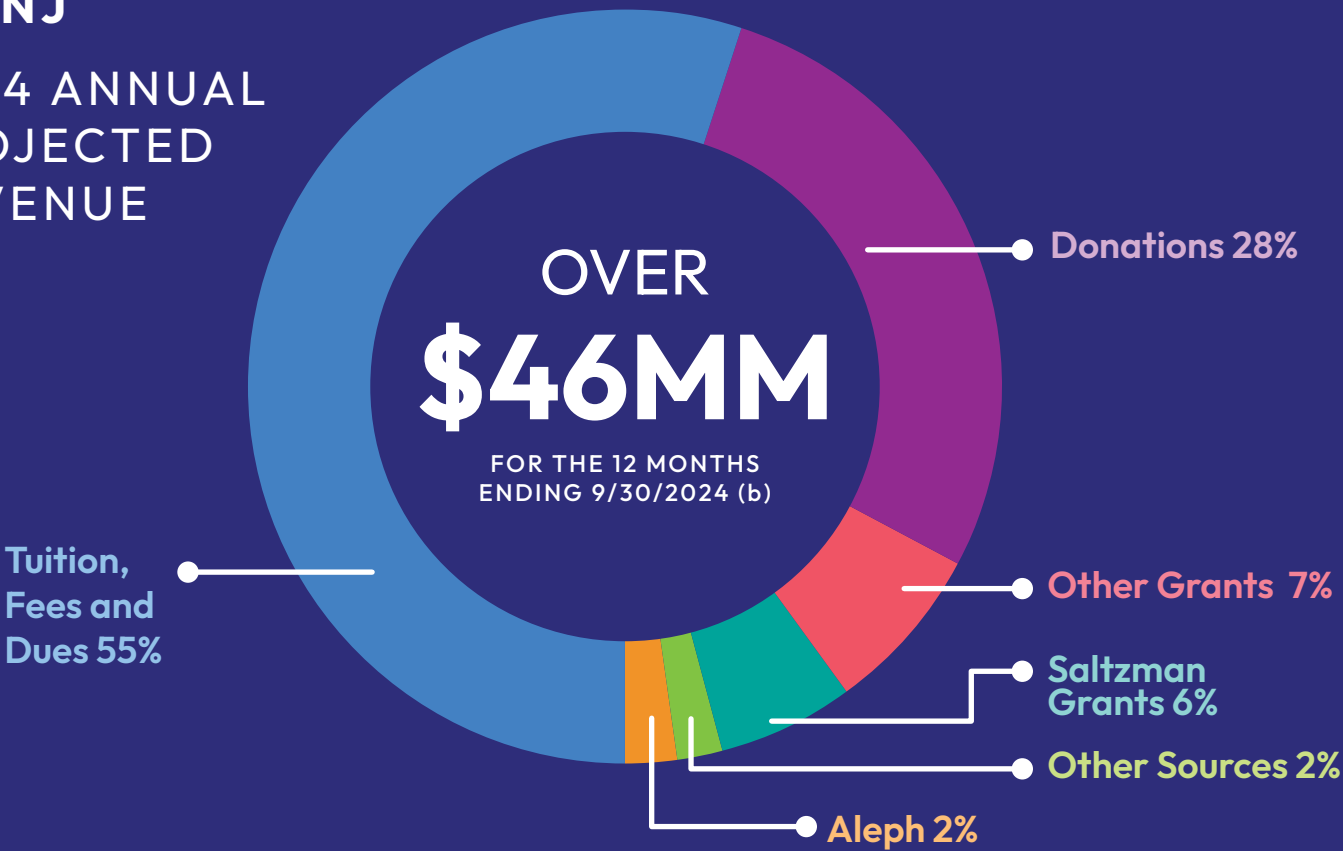

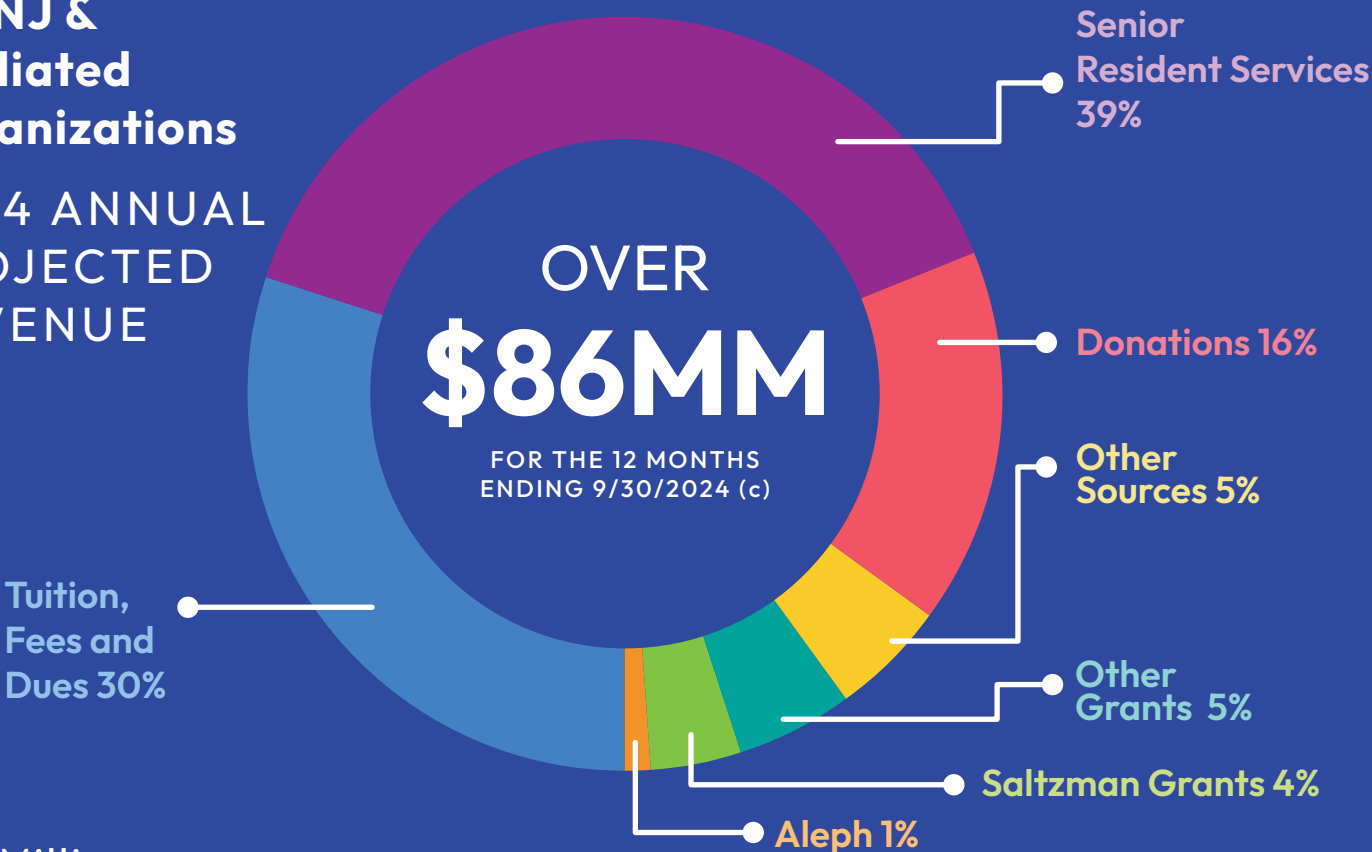
